As you read this, the second formal consultation on the Neighbourhood Plan will be underway and will continue into October.

Whichever version you read, what would help most is if you could let us know what you think of the latest version of the Plan. A huge amount of work has gone into improving it since last year's consultation, with landscape studies, a village design guide and the allocation of sites among the highlights.



Any constructive feedback is welcome. Of course, we'd like to hear that the village supports what we've done, but if you disagree with anything, we're just as keen to find out what that is, and why. There's a simple comments form on our website (with far less to fill in than at the last consultation!) and if you

prefer to do things with pen and paper, let us know and we'll get a blank form to you.
