SAHAM TONEY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN REFERENDUM

A Referendum relating to the making (adoption) of the Saham Toney Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Tuesday 26th October 2021.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if

- he or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- his or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area.

The Referendum area is the area covered by the Saham Toney Neighbourhood Plan, which is the same as the Saham Toney Parish Area.

A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address where they are entitled to be registered.

Paper copies of the Referendum Information Statement, along with the other 'specified documents', are available to view at the Breckland Council's Offices, Elizabeth House, Walpole Loke, Dereham, NR19 1EE or in Saham Toney, by phoning Breckland Council's Offices on 01362 656870 during opening hours (9am-5pm, except 3.30pm on the last Friday of the month).

- The Saham Toney Neighbourhood Development Plan;
- Report of the Independent Examiner;
- The representations summary sent to the Independent Examiner;
- A Basic Conditions Statement;
- A statement about town and country planning and Neighbourhood Plans.
