Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012

Notice is given that Saham Toney Parish Council has prepared a neighbourhood plan entitled the “Saham Toney Neighbourhood Plan 2019-2036” for the parish with the help of the local community.

The plan sets out a vision for the future of the local settlements and planning policies which will be used to determine planning applications locally.

In accordance with Regulation 16 of Part 5 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended), the Local Planning Authority must publicise the draft plan for a minimum 6 week period inviting representations on the Plan.
